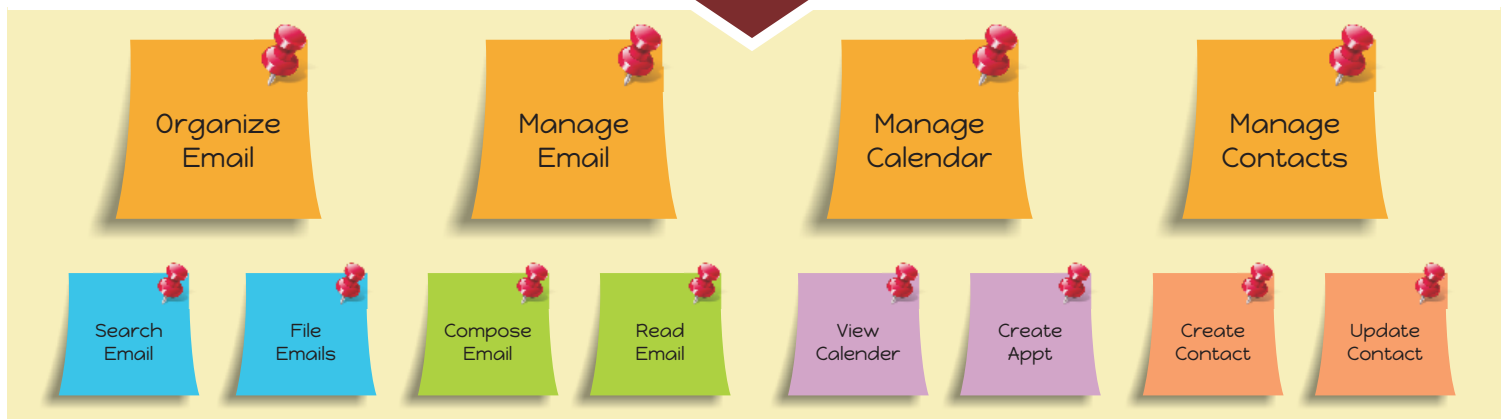


Effective User Stories for Agile Requirements

In the context of Agile Delivery, "Stories" allow the Customer, End User Consumer and the Delivery team to continually discuss Requirements and Benefits over the project lifetime, helping us to collectively discover what is really required and ensure that it is delivered.

- ✓ Stories are concise and to the point, helping everyone to remain focussed (Flow)
