2. The Standard CMMI[®] Appraisal Method for Process Improvement (SCAMPI) Version 1.3: Class A Team Training.

This two-day workshop is directed at individuals and teams who are planning a SCAMPI (Standard CMMI[®] Appraisal Method for Process Improvement). The course covers the essentials of working effectively on an appraisal team. In addition to team building exercises, it includes an overview of the SCAMPI process, terminology, SCAMPI Class A overview, and identifies the Appraisal roles, responsibilities and activities. By the end of the course you will be able to:

- Understand steps of the Class A appraisal process.
- Understand underlying principles of the Class A appraisal process
- Operate as an effective Appraisal Team Member
